### Kindergarten - Grade 3

- ▶ Complete change of school uniform clothes for emergencies (label each item with child's name)
- ▶ Reusable Water Bottle (spill proof)
- ▶ Regular-size Backpack (NO wheels, NO characters)
- ▶ Individual Headphones – no earbuds – no USB connection (for educational platforms) Students NOT to share.
- ▶ 1 Non-perishable lunch for emergencies (3-4 items in ziplock)
- ▶ 1 large box Tissues
- ▶ Girls-1 box gallon ziplock bags (grades 2 & 3)
- ▶ Boys-1 box quart ziplock bags (grades 2 & 3)

### Grades 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

- ▶ Reusable pull-top Sports Water Bottle
- ▶ Backpack (NO wheels, NO characters)
- ▶ Individual Headphones – not earbuds – with microphone (for educational platforms) Students NOT to share.
- ▶ Girls: 1 large box gallon size Ziplock bags  
Optional: 1 pack of multi-colored cardstock
- ▶ Boys: 1 large box tissues  
1 large box sandwich size Ziplock bags  
Optional: 1 pack of white cardstock
- ▶ 1 pack of construction paper
- ▶ 2 composition notebooks (wide rule)
- ▶ 2 packs of looseleaf paper (wide rule)
- ▶ 1 pack of crayons
- ▶ 1 pack of pencils (not mechanical)
- ▶ 1 white 3-ring binder (1 inch)

### Physical Education Attire Grades K-11<sup>th</sup>

#### Grades K-5

- ▶ Athletic shoes- with white or light-colored rubber-soles. (platform shoes, boots, loafers, boat shoes, and slip on shoes are NOT safe to wear for P.E.)
- ▶ No dress socks
- ▶ Reusable Water Bottle- No disposable water bottles

#### Grades 6-11

\*Uniforms shorts and shirts must be purchased from Dennis Uniform Company

- ▶ 4 P.E. Shorts \* modest fit
- ▶ 4 Yellow P.E. Shirt \*
- ▶ 4 Blue P.E. Shirt \*
- ▶ 4 Knee high sports socks (solid White-no stripes, no dress socks)
- ▶ 4 Ankle high-top **White or Light-colored Rubber-soled** athletic shoes (no converse or vans type skate shoes; no platform shoes; shoe must cover & support ankle bone)
- ▶ 4 Shin guards (found in sporting goods area of Walmart)
- ▶ 4 Knee support and Ankle support - pull on wraps (no Velcro) (found in pharmacy area of Walmart)
- ▶ 4 Reusable Water Bottle -No disposable water bottles
- ▶ 4 Mouth guard (case strongly suggested, found in sporting goods area of Walmart)
- ▶ 4 P.E. bag (can be drawstring type or duffle bag style)

### Homeroom:

- ▶ 1 package of loose leaf 3 hole punched lined notebook paper
- ▶ Pens
- ▶ #2 pencils
- ▶ Pencil pouch
- ▶ Metric ruler (metal or hard plastic)
- ▶ Headphones
- ▶ 3 large box Kleenex
- ▶ 1 container hand sanitizer

### Science:

- ▶ Sketchbook
- ▶ Watercolors & brushes (small enough to fit in pencil pouch)
- ▶ Colored Pencils

### Language Arts:

- ▶ 1 composition notebook for Bible
- ▶ 1 composition notebook for Language Arts
- ▶ 3-subject notebook for Language Arts

### Math:

## Grades 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>

- ▶ Large box of Kleenex
- ▶ 1 hand sanitizer
- ▶ Bible (Any version you find easiest to read and understand)
- ▶ Black pens/Red Pens
- ▶ #2 pencils or mechanical pencils
- ▶ Highlighters
- ▶ Scissors
- ▶ Small post-it sticky notes
- ▶ Ruler, metal or hard plastic with Metric & Standard measurements.
- ▶ Colored pencils/markers
- ▶ 1 Hardback journal (will be used for multiple classes, starting 1st week of class)

*Graphing calculators are optional as there are apps that can now graph. TI 84 Plus CE is a great, but expensive, calculator. It can be used through all of high school and college. The app is fine for high school classes but not allowed on SAT/ACT tests. WMA does have a few available for classroom use.*

### Concert Uniform:

- ▶ Girls: Navy blue skirts\*  
WMA logo white rounded-collar Peter Pan shirt\*  
Black Dress shoes with white socks
- ▶ Boys: Navy blue pants \*  
WMA logo white long sleeve oxford button-down collar shirt\*  
Clip-on Harris plaid tie\*  
Black Dress shoes with dark socks

### Steel Band – Grade 5-7 (Elective)

- ▶ Solid color polo shirt (**NOT** black)
- ▶ Black tuxedo pants

### Concert/Intermediate Band - Grades 6-12

#### Concert Uniform:

- ▶ White **tuxedo** shirt\*\*
- ▶ Black **tuxedo** pants\*\*
- ▶ Red vest and two-toned bowtie (purchase from WMA Music Dept.)
- ▶ Boys: **BLACK** dress shoes and **BLACK** socks
- ▶ Girls: Off **BLACK** hose

### Concert Choir - Grades 8-12

- Concert Band uniform except:
- ▶ Pants do not need to be tuxedo
  - ▶ Ladies wear knee length skirts

### Steel Band – Grade 8-12 (Fire 'n Steel)

#### Formal Attire:

- ▶ Select Choir uniform

#### Informal Attire:

- ▶ Black "T" shirt\*\*
- ▶ Hawaiian/Calypto shirt\*\*
- ▶ Black tuxedo pants\*\*
- ▶ Black dress shoes and **BLACK** socks
